#### General

- Part L building regulations Domestic and non domestic
- Close Date is the 31 January or when the budget is fully expired
- If the budget is not fully expired then after 31 January SEAI will accept applications under €220K
- Pre application help can be provided subject to the guidelines
- Guidelines form part of the contract and you may not make applications which are not consistent with these guidelines
- External evaluation process same as previous and their decisions on technical matters are final.
- Note Brexit considerations



## Changes to the scheme & Budget

- 1. Late delivery option
- 2. Close date 31 January contracts above €220
- 3. Schedule F requirements
- 4. Small payment for HLI assessment
- 5. Minimum score under Section C (12 Marks)

## **Budget**

Provisional Budget is €19M

SEAI will look to commit €21M Subject to demand

\*We will most likely operate a reserve list



## Late Delivery

- This provision is only where M&V is a mandatory requirement and contract is €750K
  - Why? Due to the size of contract to allow additional time for delivery
- Delivery of the contract and projects is 80% by 14<sup>th</sup> October
  - Extension element is only 20%
- This is only available when contracted and only when requested at application
- Exclusions -
  - Extensions in 2019
  - Non delivery 70% requirement 2019 contract
- Overall cap applies which is €2M
- Note we recommend you clarify in advance as we will reject any application where this is requested and you are excluded



## **Application and Process**

- Same process to be applied as 2019 application process
- 3 tracker's will be available on the web site
  - Total Budget available
  - Late delivery available
  - Housing strand
- We intend to increase the number so status so that progress is clearer
- Applications not meeting criteria will be offered a second opportunity to apply note 5 day turnaround
- Where any guidelines is breached application will be rejected



#### **Domestic**

- Changes in addresses possible
- Changes in measures not possible
- Windows means full window replacement (Every single window)
- Doors 1 Front or 1 Back
- All pricing is fixed and by measure
- We want the Sq. Meter price for measures
- Single measures not permitted
